1. Welcome and apologies

Bill Scott welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. Unpaid Carers Discussion

Linda Bamford gave an overview of the paper on Unpaid Carers. Commissioners discussed the paper. It was agreed that a working group could be set up to do a short piece on how the Commission can influence the current policy on unpaid carers. The secretariat will circulate an invite to the group and ask if any Commissioners would like to volunteer to be part of an unpaid carers working group. Commissioners suggested other organisations involved with carers to be invited to a future Commission meeting.

3. Free School Meals research

Katherine Hudson presented the paper and first draft report on Free School Meals research which the Commission had commissioned the Scottish Poverty and Inequality Research Unit (SPIRU) to undertake. Commissioners discussed the report and will provide comments to the secretariat. The report will be published on the 10

March. A Scotland/USA webinar on School Meals and COVID-19 is taking place on 10 March, Commissioners will be invited to attend the event. ASSIST FM are also holding a seminar on the same day which would allow the research to be promoted to local catering leaders

The Commissioners discussed the budget, risk register and work plan. Commissioners agreed updates to the risk register. The secretariat will confirm whether the Commission's work programme needs to be signed off by the Scottish Government sponsorship team. The unpaid carers working group will be added to the work programme.
