Members of public bodies must register certain kinds of interests – financial and non-financial. These are called "Registerable Interests". You must ensure that these interests are registered at all times and that you update them whenever relevant circumstances change. It is your duty to ensure any changes in circumstances are reported within one month of them changing. Guidance on registering interests can be found in the annex to this form.
